

Dock Street School Halloween Costume Guidelines

Dear Families,

As Halloween approaches, we are excited to see our students showcase their creativity! To ensure a fun, safe, and respectful celebration, we have set some guidelines for costumes on Halloween. Please review these with your child:

- School-Appropriate Costumes: Costumes must follow the school's dress code. They
 should not be revealing or depict inappropriate themes such as violence, drugs, or
 offensive language.
- 2. **No Masks or Face Coverings**: For safety reasons, masks or face coverings are not permitted. Light makeup is allowed as long as the student's face is visible.
- 3. **No Weapons or Dangerous Props**: Toy weapons (e.g., toy guns, swords, etc.) are not allowed. All props should be safe and non-threatening.
- 4. **Cultural Sensitivity**: Costumes that might offend or disrespect any cultural, religious, or ethnic group are not allowed. We encourage students to choose costumes that are inclusive and mindful of others.
- 5. **Safety and Mobility**: Costumes should allow students to move freely and participate in school activities without hindrance.
- 6. **Non-Distracting**: Costumes should not disrupt the learning environment. Students will need to participate in all regular school activities.
- 7. **No Full Face Paint or Glitter**: While creative makeup is allowed, excessive face paint or glitter should be avoided.
